April 2017	<p>Unit 1 : A Happy Child (Recitation with actions)</p> <p>ACTIVITY:</p> <p><u>SPEAKING</u></p> <p>1 .What makes you happy?</p> <p>Each child will try and talk about things that make him / her happy. Eg- I feel happy when I play with my friends. Encourage each child to speak even if the sentences are ungrammatical or broken. In case the child uses the mother tongue instead of forbidding him/her from doing so, rephrase the sentence in simple english and ask him/her to repeat the sentence.</p> <p>2. Talking about feelings.</p> <p>Elicit answers by asking short leading questions or showing the students pictures</p> <p>Eg. How do you feel when your friend does not talk to you?</p> <p><u>WRITING</u></p> <p>Write different words associated with happiness</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Change the number● Opposite words● Draw something that makes you happy and write one sentence about it.
