CIRCULAR

In continuation to previous circular Dated 29th October 2021, SCERT (F. No. 12 (37)NCERT/Acad./SCERT/2021/7612-24) regarding National Achievement Survey, 2021 for conveying of Introductory Memo / Advisory for every sample school and for fair and smooth conduct of NAS scheduled on 12th November 2021 and Reference circular No. DE.23 (08)/Sch. Br./2021/611, Dated: 29.10.2021, DoE School branch regarding Reopening of Schools for Students of all Classes, The HoS of the selected sampled schools for NAS 2021 are intimated to ensure the following

1. NAS will be conducted ,for Grade 3, 5, 8 and 10 students of State Govt. schools, Govt. Aided schools. Private Unaided recognized schools and Central Government schools in key curricular areas of Language, Mathematics, EVS/Science and Social Sciences
2. Ensure that each sample school remains open on Survey Day i.e., 12th Nov 2021 and the strength of the sample Grade must be full as far as possible.
3. Head of school to present the attendance register to the survey team
4. Heads of the Sampled School selected for NAS 2021 are expected to extend cooperation to conduct. And please note that this is not an examination or test. This is a diagnostic survey. • This is not an individual student performance rating or certification. • This is not an individual school performance rating or certification. • please allow the factual positions to be recorded in the larger interest of school education. This survey has very healthy objectives and therefore, it must be allowed to happen on "As is where is basis". The actual status, true information / data must be shared. Also, considering the diagnostic intent of the NAS, the schools, students and teachers may not be asked to make extra-ordinary preparations. Any pressure on the children must be avoided since NAS is not a test and it must happen in a very non-intimidating setting. Data gathered through NAS would give us true reflection of the ground realities on the learning level of students.
5. The objectives have been explained by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India and also articulated in the Assessment Framework designed and developed by the NCERT. (**Framework uploaded on NAS Portal**)
6. All the Head of the sampled schools are directed to read the documents relating to the Survey i.e Introductory Memo / Advisory for every sample school, Activity Schedule (FI & Observer), Handout (FI & Observer), Control Sheet etc. available on the **NAS portal <https://nas.education.gov.in/>** to get familiarized with the process to support the Survey Team.
7. HoS of selected sampled school may contact District Nodal officers (DNOs), or District Level Coordinators(DLCs) of their respected district at the earliest for further clarification
