While verifying the nominations by HOS, the following facts should be kept in view:


- I. Nominated teacher has not already possessed or pursuing B.Ed. degree.
- II. Nominated teacher has not been issued SAV certificate.
- III. No study leave has been granted in entire service to the nominated teacher.
- IV. Furnish Work & Conduct Report, Integrity Certificate and Vigilance Clearance Report of the nominated teacher.
- V. Preference may be given to willing and eligible senior teacher.

- VI. The selected teacher will be required to execute a bond in Form -7 and submit undertaking that he/she has not availed any kind of study leave in his/her entire service at the time of relieving to SCERT (format enclosed).
- VII. The teacher concerned will submit a copy of B.Ed. degree to HQS concerned after completion of B.Ed. successfully.



The candidates would apply through proper channel in E-IV Branch, Directorate of Education, Old Secretariat and the department shall forward the list of eligible nominated Assistant Teachers (DOE) deputed for B.Ed. programme (Session 2022-2024) and also be prepare the waiting list of 10 Assistant Teachers, latest by 10.08.2022. The criteria for the In-service B.Ed. course are as under:

1. Academic Qualification:

Candidate with at least 45% marks either in Bachelors degree and/ or in the Masters degree in Sciences, Social Sciences, and Humanities.

OR

Bachelors in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 50% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto.

V. Candidates must have passed at least two subjects out of the following list of the teaching methodology subjects (as mentioned in **LIST -I** below)

VI. These two subjects should be available as teaching subjects in the institute/college in which the candidate seek to take admission. (the List of Teaching subjects offered by SCERT is given as LIST-II)

VII. Candidates are advised not to choose two languages as teaching methodology subjects.

VIII. University shall abide strictly to the NCTE norms for admission and shall not be responsible for the further job prospects of the students.

EMPLOY, WHEN PROCEEDING ON STUDY LEAVE**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, resident of
in the District of at present employed as in the Ministry/Office of
..... do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to pay to the
President of India (hereinafter called "the Government") on demand the sum of Rs.
(Rs. only) together with interest thereon from the date of demand at
Government rates for the time being in force on Government loans or, if payment is made in a
country other than India, the equivalent of the said amount in the currency of that country
converted at the official rate of exchange between that country and India AND TOGETHER
with all costs between attorney and client and all charges and expenses that shall or may have
been incurred by the Government.

WHEREAS I am granted study leave by Government.

AND WHEREAS for the better protection of the Government I have agreed to execute this
Bond with such condition as hereunder is written:

NOW THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE WRITTEN OBLIGATION IS THAT in the event
of my failing to resume duty, or resigning or retiring from service or otherwise quitting service
without returning to duty after the expiry or termination of the period of study leave or failing to
complete the course of study or at any time within a period of three years/five years after my
return to duty, I shall forthwith pay to the Government or as may be directed by the
Government, on demand the said sum of Rs. (Rupees. only) together
with interest thereon from the date of demand at Government rates for the time being in force
on Government loans.

NOW FURTHER THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE WRITTEN OBLIGATION IS THAT
the period of my bond mandating putting in service for the period as specified above, after
expiry of the study leave availed by me, shall be extended by a comparable period, equivalent to
the aggregate periods of leave of any kind availed by me, during the currency of the bond
period.

AND upon my making such payment, the above written obligations shall be void and of no
effect, otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and virtue.

The Bond shall in all respects be governed by the laws of India for the time being in force and
the rights and liabilities hereunder shall, where necessary, be accordingly determined by the
appropriate Courts of India.

predetermined and stipulated amounts from the Government servant who fails to discharge his
obligation.
