No. F.2(10)/59-R&S.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' Notification No. F.27/59-Him.(i), dated the 13th July, 1959, the Chief Commissioner, Delhi is pleased to make rules in the Schedule hereto annexed regarding the method of recruitment and qualifications necessary for appointment to the post of Educational and Vocational Guidance Counsellor (Class III) under the Directorate of Education, Delhi.

(1) For an inspection, examination or test of a high voltage luminous tube signs installations or a high voltage electrodiate Boiler or high frequency X-Ray installation Rs. 20/-.

No. F.15(56)/58-LSG.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (1) of Section 48 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, the Chief Commissioner, Delhi, is pleased to withdraw from the acquisition of land covered by his declaration No. F.15(56)/58-LSG, dated the 10th July, 1959, published at page 176 in part IV of the Delhi Gazette dated the 23rd July, 1959.

No. F.15(26)/59-LSG.—Whereas the Chief Commissioner, Delhi, vide his orders, Nos. F.15(26)/59-LSG (ii), and No. F. 15(26)/59-LSG(iii), dated the 24th April, 1959, directed the Land Acquisition Collector, Delhi to procure the occupation and use of the land described in the respective specification thereto for a period of one year from the commencement of such occupations, for a public purpose, namely, for the construction of a part of a bund from Shah Alam Bridge to Coronation Memorial (near Village Dhaka and Dhirpur and whereas by his subsequent notification No. 15(26)/59-LSG, dated the 14th May, 1960, the Chief Commissioner further directed the Land Acquisition Collector, Delhi to procure the occupation and use of the said land for the said purpose for a further period of 2 months and 27 days i.e. upto 31st July, 1960.

And whereas the construction of the said bund has not yet been completed and the temporary use and occupation of the land at Village Dhirpur are still needed for the said purpose for a further period of one month i.e. upto the 31st August, 1960.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (i) of Section 35 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, the Chief Commissioner is pleased to direct the Land Acquisition Collector, to continue the temporary occupation and use of the land described in the specification below for a further period of one month that is, upto the 31st August, 1960.

In the said Schedule:—

(i) for the existing entries under columns 3 (Classification), (Scale of pay) and 6 (Age limit for direct recruits), the following shall be substituted:—

Column 4	"Rs. 550-25-750-EB-30-900".
Column 6	"Below 36 years (Relaxable in case of widows(deserted wives/Govt. servants and those teaching Universities upto 45 years)".

(ii) under N. B. (ii) the following shall be added :—

"(iii) Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(iv) Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of the rules with respect to a class or category of persons/posts.

(v) The crucial date for determining the age limit mentioned in the column 6 of the recruitment rules will in each case, be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India other than Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep). In respect of posts, the appointments to which are made through the Employment Exchanges, the crucial date for determining the age limit will, in each case, be the last date upto which the Employment Exchanges are asked to submit the names.
