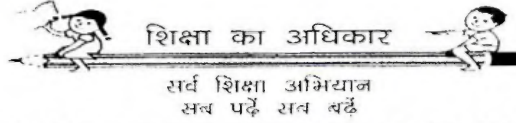

Guidelines for Heads of Schools

All Heads of schools are directed to ensure the Celebration of Language Festivals in schools in true spirit of National Integration. The HoS must ensure that:-

- The Bhasha-Sangam booklet is downloaded from the epathshala website (<http://epathshala.gov.in>) and further clicking on Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Menu.
- The Day-wise/Date-wise schedule of the languages to be covered in a month must be followed i.e. 20th Nov. 2019 to 16th Dec.2019. The scheduled is also enclosed with these guidelines.
- In case, if any school is unable to conduct activity on any particular day, then, the same language activity may be taken up after the completion of all other scheduled language activities of the month.
- 5-sentences pertaining to the language of the day should be read out in morning assembly by any teacher or student who speaks that language fluently and correctly or belongs to that state.
- All the students will be asked to repeat these 5 sentences.
- On some days, parents or other persons who speak that language fluently & correctly may be invited to read out these lines and also share their experiences in that target language.
- Teachers may be directed to address the students and converse with them in the language of the day.
- Students may be encouraged to converse in the language of the day.

- Students may also be encouraged to share these sentences with their families at home.
- Other than speaking the five sentences, students may also recite poems/ sing songs /present small skit in the language of that particular day.
- Photography & Videography of the morning assembly activities may be done during the month, and further shared at district and state level. Some good videos and photographs may be uploaded on the epathshaala website.
- Children may be encouraged to prepare displayboards based on the theme of Language of Day.
- School may give awards/prizes to the best 3 selected board/Posters utilizing the fund.
- The amount of Rs. 1000/- may utilized for these above mentioned activities.
- The utilization certificate may be forwarded to concerned DPO along with a detailed report of activities of language celebration in the schools.
