Subject: Mapping of Madrasas, Sanskrit schools, Gurukuls, and Pathshalas Action Taken Report

With reference to the letter received from NCPCR Letter F.No 25016/10/2024-25/NCPCR/EDU/DD26534 dated 25.06.2024 (Copy enclosed), all Deputy Directors of Education (District) are requested to initiate the process of collecting data to map all Madrasas, Sanskrit schools, Gurukuls, and Pathshalas operating under their jurisdiction.

To achieve this, Deputy Directors of Education (District) are instructed to:

Conduct a fresh survey in their respective zones.

2. Collaborate with Samagra staff in their districts to complete the mapping exercise within 10 days of the issuance of this circular, for the academic session 2024-25 in UDISE+ Data Capturing Format (DCF)

A prompt response is appreciated, as this will enable the submission of a comprehensive action taken report to NCPCR.

Subject: Regarding granting UDISE Code to Madrasas_reg.

Sir,

As you are aware, the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) is a statutory body constituted under Section 3 of the Commission for Protection of Child Rights (CPCR) Act, 2005 to protect the rights of children and address other related matters in the Country. The Commission is further mandated to monitor the proper and effective implementation Right to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009.

- Your kind attention is drawn to the Article 21A of the Constitution of India that provides free and compulsory education of all children in the age group of 6-14 years as a Fundamental Right in a manner as the State may by law determine. Consequently, the RTE Act, 2009 was enacted in 2010 to extend the fundamental right to elementary education. The Commission while monitoring the implementation of the RTE Act, 2009 had came across the issue of a large number of children who do not attend school but attend religious institutions such as Madrasas. To further understand the issue, the Commission undertook a study and found that there are three types of Madrasa that are functional in the country- Recognized, Unrecognized and Unmapped. It was also observed by the Commission that the exact number of unmapped Madrasa and number of children attending those Madrasas was not available. Further, whether these children are enrolled in schools and receiving fundamental education was also not clear.
- 3. Taking cognizance of the issue, the Commission then wrote to Chief Secretaries of all States to conduct a detailed inquiry of Madrasas enrolling non-muslim children and also undertake mapping of unmapped Madrasas in the State. During this process, the Commission came to know that in different States, Madrsasa are getting Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE) Codes despite not fulfilling the norms and standards as per the RTE Act, 2009.
- 4. You are therefore requested to issue necessary directions to all States/UTs to conduct inspections of the existing Madrasas with UDISE Code. The recognition and UDISE Code of

It is further requested that as the UDISE system is the source of data for the school education system with respect to schools, the same may not be extended to Madrasas. A separate category of UDISE may be created to capture information about all Madrasas including recognized, unrecognized and unmapped.

5. You are requested to share the action taken in this regard with the Commission within 15 days of issuance of this letter.
