

In a first of its kind initiative, DMEO, NITI Aayog aims to engage Central/ State universities to undertake assessments of select Government of India schemes. The exercise aims at building M&E capacities of the students by orienting them on data collection, data analysis and report writing by providing them an opportunity to gain hands-on experience in the field.

2. Round I of this initiative was undertaken in pilot mode covering 8 GoI schemes. The Round — I of the study built capacities of students from 10 universities in 10 states. The report for which is under preparation. In order to further augment capacity and leverage existing expertise at the state level, DMEO is conducting the Round II of the Capacity Building in M&E of Central and State Universities in 14 states (list at Annexure I). The Round II of capacity building envisages assessment of four Government of India schemes focused on the health and education of students in Classes I-VIII, namely- Samagra Shiksha Abhiyyan (SSA), PM Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM-POSHAN), Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) and Rashtriya Kishore Swasthya Karyakram (RKSK).

3. The Letter of Awards have been accepted by the universities and the survey by the universities will be initiated in the coming month. The field work will be completed in 3-month post which state and national level reports will be finalized. The findings of the study will also be shared with DOSEL.

4. In this regard, we seek cooperation from DOSEL to give necessary instructions to the State Education Departments to facilitate the survey in government schools, government-aided schools and private schools.


