CIRCULAR

In continuation of this Directorate circular dated 20.09.2024 regarding "Guidelines for admission under EWS/Freeship category in classes from 2nd onwards in Private Unaided Recognized Schools of Delhi (except minority) running on land allotted by DDA/Government allotted land for the academic session 2024-25 selected through Computerized Draw of lots by DoE",

In this regard, the subsection 3 of section 5 of RTE Act, 2009 has provided that delay in producing transfer certificate shall not be a ground for either delaying or denying admission in such other school. Further, the section 4 and section 5 of RTE Act, 2009 are as under:-

Section 4 Special provisions for children not admitted to, or who have not completed, elementary education.-Where a child above six years of age has not been admitted in any school or though admitted, could not complete his or her elementary education, then, he or she shall be admitted in a class appropriate to his or her age:

Provided that where a child is directly admitted in a class appropriate to his or her age, then, he or she shall, in order to be at par with others, have a right to receive special training, in such manner, and within such time-limits, as may be prescribed:

Provided further that a child so admitted to elementary education shall be entitled to free education till completion of elementary education even after fourteen years.

Section 5 Right of transfer to other school.-(1) Where in a school, there is no provision for completion of elementary education, a child shall have a right to seek transfer to any other school, excluding the school specified in sub-clauses (iii) and (iv) of clause (n) of section 2, for completing his or her elementary education.

(2) Where a child is required to move from one school to another, either within a State or outside, for any reason whatsoever, such child shall have a right to seek transfer to any other school, excluding the school specified in sub-clauses (iii) and (iv) of clause (n) of section 2, for completing his or her elementary education.

(3) For seeking admission in such other school, the Head-teacher or in-charge of the school where such child was last admitted, shall immediately issue the transfer certificate:

Provided that delay in producing transfer certificate shall not be a ground for either delaying or denying admission in such other school:

Provided further that the Head-teacher or in-charge of the school delaying issuance of transfer certificate shall be liable for disciplinary action under the service rules applicable to him or her.

All the district DDEs are directed to ensure the admission of all the allotted candidates under EWS/Freeship category in classes from 2nd onwards in Private Unaided Recognized Schools of Delhi (except minority) running on land allotted by DDA/Government allotted land for the academic session 2024-25 selected through Computerized Draw of lots by DoE in light of section 4 & section 5 of RTE Act, 2009.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
