Kala Utsav aligns with several key recommendations of the NEP-2020, reflecting its significance in promoting holistic and comprehensive education. Theme of this Kala Utsav will be: "Viksit Bharat-A Vision for Bharat in the year 2047.

All District Coordinators appointed by District DDEs are directed to organize Kala Utsav competitions in their respective Districts tentatively between 25.08.2025 to 30.08.2025 and submit the result latest by 02.09.2025 to the office of the undersigned.

The State Level Kala Utsav 2025 is tentatively scheduled to be held from **08.09.2025to 12.09.2025**.

General Instructions District Level-2025.

- 1. Kala Utsav 2025 will be held in majorly 12 Categories and commonly for Girls & Boys both. There will be no separate competition for Girls and Boys.
- 2. Entries for Kala Utsav will inculde only students who are studying in Class 9th to 12th of all Government, Government Aided and Private Schools.
- 3. Students should prepare their presentations or programmes under the supervision of school authorities.
- 4. One student can participate only in one event.
- 5. A team comprising of 3 judges (One set of judges) should be enganged per event.
- 6. Participation of Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Group (SEDG) including Children with Special Needs (CWSN) at all levels to be ensured.
- 7. District wise compiled result of all the events of Kala Utsav (Hard copies and Soft Copies) and other required documents must be submitted to the office of the Physical Education Branch, Chhatrasal Stadium, Model Town Delhi.
- 8. The textual summary should be submitted (by the winners of State Level) along with the entry. 5 photos in JPEG Format of the participant during the making of their art piece or giving performance etc. should be given.
- 9. The textual summary will include details like its origin, communities, practice of the selected art form.
- 10. In State Level Kala Utsav Competition 2025 only 1st position holders of all the events from 12 Districts will participate.
- 11. The list of District Coordinators in enclosed.
- 12. All DDE Districts must ensure maximum participation of students in the event.
