CIRCULAR

Sub: Observance of World Malaria Day on 25th April, 2025.

World Malaria Day, observed every year on April 25, is a globally recognized occasion, established by the World Health Organization (WHO) to raise awareness about malaria. It highlights the global efforts being made to control and eliminate the disease and mobilize action and resources to curb malaria.

As per the letter (copy enclosed) received from NVBD Control Programme, Integrated District Health Society, New Delhi, the theme for this year is **"Malaria Ends With Us: Reinvest, Reimagine, Reignite"**, emphasizing the need for renewed investment, innovative approaches and a reignited global commitment to eliminate the disease.

Guidelines for Observance of World Malaria Day at Schools:

All Heads of Govt./ Govt Aided / Pvt. Unaided Recognized Schools under the Directorate of Education shall ensure:

- Sensitization of students, teachers & other staff in morning assembly regarding prevention and control of Vector Borne Diseases.
- Quiz/poster designing/slogan writing competition etc. may be organized in schools to create awareness among students.
- Special drives in school premises for the removal of scraps, stagnant water and any mosquito breeding sites etc, may be conducted.
- Students may be given assignments and activities to check the stagnant water in and around their houses.
- Do's and Don'ts for Vector Borne Diseases and other IEC material may be displayed at notice boards.
- Demonstration of larvae, mosquitos, diagnostic kits, bed nets etc. may be done in schools in coordination with local bodies.

A compiled action taken report may be submitted by DDE (District) for the various activities conducted on World Malaria Day in the schools of their respective districts on email id: healthschoolbranch@gmail.com by 26.04.2025.



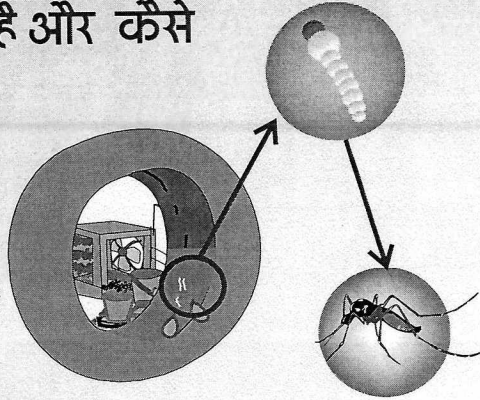

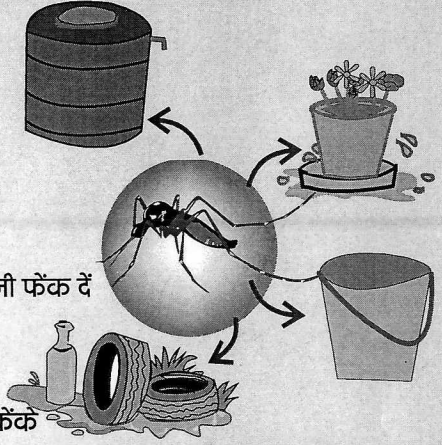
जांच एवं उपचार

मलेरिया से बचाव

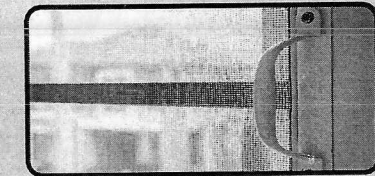
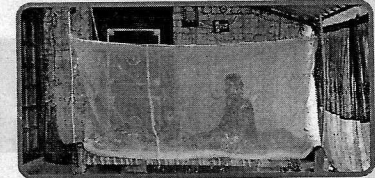
1. मच्छरों को पैदा होने से रोकें

- अपने घर के आसपास सफाई रखें
- घर के आसपास पानी जमा न होने दें, बेकार पानी फेंक दें
- पानी के सभी बर्तनों को ढक कर रखें

The theme for this year is **"Malaria Ends With Us: Reinvest, Reimagine, Reignite"**, emphasizing the need for renewed investment, innovative approaches, and a reignite global commitment to eliminate the disease.

In this regard to take following activities:

At Health Facilities/Sentinel Surveillance Hospitals (SSHs)

- Checking of premises for water stagnation and mosquito breeding to ensure mosquito free health facility/ hospital.
- Patients/Attendants in the OPDs may be sensitized through Health Talks on prevention and control of Malaria
- Distribution and display of Handbills/pamphlets containing DO's and Don'ts on prevention and control of Vector Borne Diseases.
- Health facilities/ SSH may organize public meetings/ community meetings in their catchment areas through MOs/ ANMs /ASHAs to generate awareness.
- Demonstration of larvae, mosquitos, diagnostic kits, bed nets etc. may be done in coordination with local bodies.
- Health facilities/SSHs may ensure adequate stock of medicines, diagnostic kits, consumables, reagents etc.
- Health facilities/SSHs may ensure accurate and timely reporting of each suspected/ confirmed Malaria case on IHIP-IDSP and also ensure Complete treatment as per the guidelines.
