- ii. On the occasion of the Teachers Day (5th September 2025), 08 teachers from each school.

Booking procedure:

Booking can be done through Registration on the website <https://rashtrapatibhavan.gov.in> for the slot required. They will be treated as on duty and the teachers have to carry valid ID Card.

Schools will have three options to book their visits:

Further, all the HoSs of Govt. Aided/ Private Unaided Recognized schools may also book the slot for their sport teachers on 29th August 2025 (National Sports Day) & other teachers on 5th September 2025 (Teachers Day).

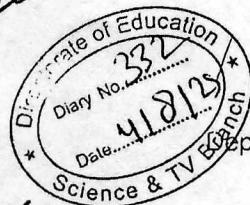

2. The upcoming edition has even more exciting elements for the visitors to explore. Udyan will remain open from 10 am to 6 pm (last entry by 5:15 pm) every day during this period, except Mondays.

3. It will be a flowering extravaganza where visitors can witness Coleus, Celosia, Tuberose and many other rare seasonal flowers in full glory. The key attraction will be the beautiful new setups in Amrit Udyan and many other surprises in store for the visitors. Further, visitors can spend time in multiple attractions, a specially curated garden for children called Bal Vatika with a story of a 225-year-old Sheesham tree, a tree house, Nature's classroom etc. Then there are the Bonsai, Circular Garden with a diverse variety of flora and fauna. There is also a vibrant food court where visitors can have refreshments. 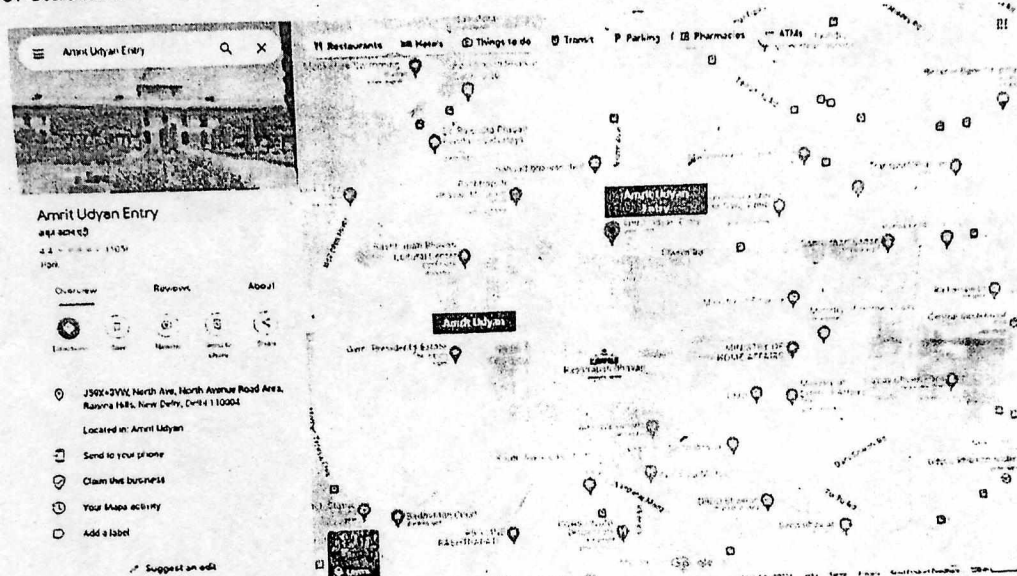
