CIRCULAR

Sub: Organization of Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad in all the Schools under Directorate of Education on 25th July, 2026 on Child Safety and Protection.

Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad serves as an important platform for meaningful and time-to-time interaction between parents and teachers, enabling a deeper understanding of a student's academic progress and overall development. Such periodic engagements provide an opportunity to review the students' performance, address concerns and jointly plan strategies for continuous improvement.

All Heads of Govt. and Govt. Aided Schools under Directorate of Education are hereby informed that in order to strengthen school-parent engagement and ensure holistic development of students, first **Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad** for the academic session 2026-27 shall be conducted on Saturday, 25th July, 2026 for all classes.

The month of July is being observed as 'Child Safety Month' in all the Govt., Govt. Aided and Unaided Private Recognized Schools under DoE. Therefore, it has been decided that the theme of the Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad to be held on 25th July, 2026 shall be "Child Safety and Protection". The schedule is as under:

Morning/General Shift	08:30 AM to 12:30 PM
Evening Shift.	02:00 PM to 06:00 PM

The focus area of this Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad shall be Child Safety and Protection under the POCSO Act, 2012. The following key points may be discussed during the Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad:

1. Brief overview of the POCSO Act, 2012 and the commitment of the Directorate of Education towards ensuring child safety in all schools.
2. Constitution of the Child Protection Committee (CPC) in schools and the availability of child protection mechanisms.
3. Importance of teaching children about body autonomy, safe and unsafe touch, personal boundaries and the "No-Go-Tell" principle.
4. Encouraging children to identify trusted adults and report any inappropriate behaviour without fear.
5. Promoting safe use of the internet and social media, including awareness about cyberbullying, online grooming and protection of personal information.
6. Importance of maintaining open communication between parents and children and recognising early signs of emotional distress, bullying or abuse.
7. Information regarding complaint and reporting mechanisms available in schools, including the Child Helpline (1098) and the legal obligation to report child safety concerns.
8. The role of parents in supporting children's emotional well-being, ensuring regular school attendance and cooperating with the school in creating a safe learning environment.

● Inform the parents regarding student and parent awareness provisions in 'Student Safety Checklist' attached with the circular issued by the EVGB, DoE.

In addition, discussions should extend to the students' attitude towards learning, peer interactions and overall emotional health. Teachers may guide parents on effective strategies to support their child at home, including creating a positive learning environment, managing stress and encouraging healthy study habits.

Class Teachers should remain present in their respective classrooms throughout the Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad. They should interact individually with the parents of each student for at least 5–10 minutes to discuss the academic activities planned for the session and the efforts being made to enhance the student's learning outcomes.

Parents should be encouraged to minimize their children's involvement in domestic chores, as far as possible, so that they can devote adequate time to their studies. Teachers should also provide practical guidance to parents on supporting their child's learning at home, encouraging regular interaction, creating a conducive study environment and actively partnering in their child's academic progress.

All Heads of Schools are directed to ensure:

- Proper planning and wide dissemination of Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad among parents.
- Active participation of teachers and parents.
- Maintenance of records of discussions and feedback received.
- Necessary follow-up actions based on concerns raised during the Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad.
- Teachers will obtain signature of parents/guardians on a separate sheet as a mark of their attendance in the Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad.
- Class Teachers will prepare a list of students whose parents/guardians did not attend the Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad. List of such students would be kept by the concerned Head of School who shall ensure that such parents/guardians are called to visit school at a later date through SMS / Phone Call / Letter etc.
- Feedback received from the parents/guardians shall be noted diligently by each class/ subject teacher and the same shall be brought to the notice of Head of School so that actionable suggestions may be implemented.
- All the Class Teachers shall maintain an updated record of mobile numbers of parents/guardians in respect of all the students of their class so that regular and continuous communication may be made between school and parents/guardians.
- Before conducting Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad, Head of School may hold a staff meeting in order to inform all teaching staff about the main issues to be discussed with parents. EVGC deployed in school may brief teachers about Child Safety and Protection under the POCSO Act so that the same may be conveyed to parents in the Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad.
- HoS shall send the attendance of parents in the Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad to the concerned DDE (Zone) immediately after the completion of Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad in the below given format:

- All DDEs (District) shall submit a consolidated report of their respective district regarding details of number of parents attended the Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad Saturday, 25th July, 2026 in the Google Sheet as under:

- Provision for tea and biscuits for the parents/guardians shall be made by the concerned Head of School. Expenditure in this regard shall be met from PWF/ SMC Fund in Govt. Schools on the basis of their enrolment as per guidelines in last issued circular in this regard.

All Unaided Private Recognized Schools under Directorate of Education shall also organize Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad on the subject of Child Safety and Protection preferably on Saturday, 25th July, 2026 or any convenient date before the end of July month positively.

All schools under MCD, NDMC and Delhi Cantonment Board may also hold Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad on the subject of Child Safety and Protection on Saturday, 25th July, 2026.

All RDEs/ DDEs (District/ Zone) are hereby requested to ensure that Abhibhavak Shikshak Samvaad gets conducted smoothly in schools under their jurisdiction and visit at least two schools under their jurisdiction.
